

4.4 Operation of Training Programs

- 4.4.1** All interns and residents training at the Hospital or attending to patients at the Hospital shall be selected by the Hospital and the Program Directors and Director of Medical Education shall advise OU-COM of such selection in accordance with policies and procedures developed by the Hospital's Director of Medical Education.
- 4.4.2** Advancement of medical students, interns and residents shall be based upon evidence of satisfactory clinical knowledge and skill, professional behavior, ethical standards, patient/staff interactions and demonstrated ability to assume increasing responsibility for patient care as determined by the Hospital Director of Medical Education and/or the OU-COM CORE Assistant Dean, whichever individual is appropriate. The Hospital retains the right to determine proficiency and renewal or reappointment and should advise OU-COM of such advancement. The Hospital may terminate its relationship with a medical student, intern or resident at any time in accordance with either Hospital policies and procedures developed by the Hospital's Director of Medical Education.
- 4.4.3** The Hospital postdoctoral programs are under the full control and authority of the Hospital. All decisions regarding continuation of such programs, application for certification of such programs and all other decisions regarding such programs shall be made by the Hospital. The Hospital may adopt rules and regulations in order to ensure orderly and effective operation of the Hospital's teaching programs.
